SEEDING: Riders will be seeded into motos for the Sunday meeting from the results of the 3 motos at the Saturday event.

MOTO DRAW: Saturday – Computer Scrambled motos
Sunday - UCI Transfer system

MINIMUM CLASS SIZE 5 riders constitute a class (amalgamations as required).
Class sizes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

RACING FORMAT – Championship, Challenge 20" & Cruiser Classes:

SATURDAY: 3 motos.
These motos will be used to determine the seeding for the Nationals meeting to be held on the Sunday. Points will not be carried over to Sunday.

SUNDAY: 3 motos for all classes, with finals and transfer per UCI rules.
In each moto, the riders will ride the same riders.
At the end of the motos, the top scoring riders (normally top 4) will progress to qualifiers (semi's etc) as required using the following matrix:

5-8 riders:	Points over 3 motos
9 -16 riders:	Final.
17-32 riders:	Semi finals and Final.
33- 64 riders:	Quarter finals, Semi finals and Final.
64+ riders:	As required. (Refer www.uci.ch rules/BMX

NOTES:

1. Transfer to Quarter and Semi finals, will be under UCI rules, Chapter 6, appendix 1.
2. In case of disruption or adverse weather, moto format may be changed, at the discretion of Race Director, Chief Commissaire and/or BMX NZ.

CHAMPIONSHIP (JUNIOR & ELITE) 20" FORMAT:
Championship riders will run on the same format with seeding rounds on Saturday and 3 motos plus finals on Sunday. No purse will be offered for the Championship classes at this event.

SUPERCLASS FORMAT:

Sunday racing only – Scrambled motos - Pro track is compulsory for this event.

Classes of 8 or less:

Riders will compete in 4 motos with points aggregated.

Classes of 9 or more:

Riders will compete in 3 motos and then the top 8 to 3 finals.

Block racing will be held with intervals of approximately 20 minutes.

Purse will be proportionally split between the male and female classes based on number of entries and then payout to 8th place.

Note: Must also enter and compete in a Challenge or Championship class to enter the Superclass.

AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Perpetual Cups to all 1st Place winners

Classes with 8 riders or less:

Trophies and Race Plates to 3rd place

Classes with 9 riders:

Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 7th place

Classes with 10 riders or more:

Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 8th place

Medallions for all participants

Personalised certificates will be sent to clubs as soon as available.

Teams will be selected to travel to Australia to represent NZ in the
Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test.

The selection is open to **all riders** who will be 11 years old (actual age) on **1 June 2013**.

<u>Format Mighty 11's:</u>	All Riders	4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;
	8 or less riders	Points added to 5 th (final) moto to determine top 5 placings.
	9 - 24 riders	Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.
	25 + riders	Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

*Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary.
Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied. Olympic lane draw for Semi finals and Finals*

GATE: 8 Lane Gate.

POINTS: 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6 – 7 – 8 BMX NZ Moto Mixing.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All riders must compete in the 2013 BMX National Championships
2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. (Copies available upon request from the BMX NZ Administrator admin@bmxnz.co.nz). Contracts to be signed on the day of selection.
3. Riders must attend arranged team training sessions as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management.
4. Riders must be available to travel to Australia – during May & June 2013. During this period riders will be billeted or accommodated only as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management. (Late returns with family are possible by arrangement).
5. All riders must have current passports and entry rights into Australia.
6. All riders must abide by the rules and regulations as set by BMX NZ.
